

Unit 4: Make A Shape



This unit introduces common two-dimensional flat shapes and the language and maths concepts associated with them. Children will be able to name the shapes and recognise the shape words. The shapes are triangles, squares, rectangles, stars, circles, hearts and diamonds. Children have opportunities to learn about and sort shapes, make patterns from them and sequence them. They will also be able to match shape words to symbols through interaction with the learning objects.

Objectives

- To identify common two-dimensional flat shapes
- To match sight words and common nouns used in this unit
- To name common shapes and their symbols
- To match shape symbols and shape words (for the more advanced user)
- To sequence shape patterns in order
